Dear Parents,

Welcome to the beginning of a new school year! The staff and I are very excited to learn how our students spent their summer, rekindle and build new relationships, and begin exciting and meaningful learning experiences.

The first day of school is Wednesday, August 16<sup>th</sup>. It is my belief that Wohlwend Elementary staff is well prepared to continue supporting students to make strong academic gains while maintaining the tradition of modeling positive character traits and having high expectations.

Our regular school year hours are 8:45 a.m. to 3:35 p.m. The office is open daily from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. During the summer, the office is open from 8:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m.

#### **Important Dates**

Kindergarten Orientation / Curriculum Night – On Thursday, August 10<sup>th</sup>, from 6:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., kindergarten students and their parents will meet their teachers and learn about the school year. The students will have the opportunity to take a ride on a school bus with our assistant principal, Mrs. Durham, and me while parents talk with the teachers about the kindergarten curriculum.

Meet the Teacher Night - Parents and students in 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grades are invited to attend Meet the Teacher at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. The students are welcome to talk with their teachers and drop off their supplies from 5:30 p.m. until 6:15 p.m.

New Parent Breakfast - Parents of kindergarten children and new students to the building are welcome to attend our New Parent Breakfast at 10:00 a.m. in the cafeteria on August 16<sup>th</sup>. Join us to learn about building procedures and our parent organization while meeting staff members and each other. Please RSVP for the New Parent Breakfast by calling 467-6500 by August 11<sup>th</sup>.

Curriculum Night – Parents are invited to meet with their child's teacher to learn about what the kids will be learning this year. Teachers will also discuss classroom procedures and talk about the special activities that will take place over the course of the school year. Curriculum Night begins at 6:00 PM on Thursday, August 31st. There will be two sessions, one at 6:00 and a second at 6:30.

 $5^{th}$  Grade Parent Meeting – A parent meeting to plan all the special  $5^{th}$  grade activities will be held on Wednesday, September  $6^{th}$  at 6:30 p.m. in the library.

#### **Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures**

Parents choosing to drive their children to school may begin dropping them off at 8:35 a.m. Upon entering the parking lot, veer to the right of the driveway and enter the marked drop-off lane. Officer Sirles, our St. Louis County Police SRO, will direct you to turn right onto the drive by our front entrance. Keep your children in the car until directed by school personnel, who will assist them safely into the building. Students may not arrive at school before 8:35 a.m. unless they are participating in a previously scheduled and supervised activity or participating in the Y-Care program.

Families who pick-up their children after school should begin lining their vehicles up in the drop-off lane at approximately 3:25 p.m. After all buses have arrived on the bus parking lot, you will be directed to the driveway that circles behind Oakville Middle School. Once the buses are dismissed, the line will pull around the circle by the cafeteria. Three vehicles will be loaded at a time. There is no need to leave your vehicle with this system, and on a typical day, all students will be in their vehicles and on their way home by 3:45 p.m. The office will make your family an identification card if you pick your children up from school. Please place your identification card on your dashboard to help expedite afternoon dismissal.

Students who ride buses will load and unload on the parking lot near the cafeteria. Bus route schedules will be forthcoming via email.

If you need to pick your child up before dismissal, you must send a note to the classroom teacher and arrange to pick up your child in the office no later than 3:20 p.m. Due to safety concerns, students must get approval from me to walk to and from school or be escorted by a legal guardian.

An emergency contact form will be sent home on Meet the Teacher Night (or on the first day of school if you are unable to attend Meet the Teacher). Please make sure that you

update any emergency numbers and have completed any remaining immunizations or physical examinations prior to the beginning of the school year.




